In addition to our usual in-house concerts, our students performed a Christmas concert at TUS Millennium Theatre & a summer concert at St John's Cathedral. Advanced students performed lunchtime recitals at the Irish World Academy of Music & Dance at UL and also at St Mary's Cathedral.

Masterclasses have become a regular feature of the musical year for our students and this year's guest teachers included Katherine Hunka (violin) and Owen Lorigan (piano) among others. We also host intensive rehearsal days such as our annual "Blow Out" day for the Wind & Brass players. LSOM Alumní & Friends Fund

2022 also saw the launch of the *LSOM Alumni & Friends Fund* which was established to provide assistance with music education for deserving students. LSOM Alumni and world-renowned composers Bill Whelan and Patrick Cassidy helped to launch this fund as part of our 60th anniversary celebrations.

With the funding raised in 2022 – 2023, the *Alumni & Friends Fund* has provided support to LSOM students in a number of ways:

- purchase of instruments and sheet-music resources for our instrument bank and our partnership programmes;
- support for participation in the Cross Border Orchestra of Ireland (New York Tour)
- purchase of a piano for long-term loan to a deserving family (funded by the Catherine Shinnors Scholarship donated by John Shinnors to the LSOM Alumni & Friends Fund).
- we were extremely honoured to have received a posthumous donation of a Steinway A grand piano from the estate of Hans Reddering which is available for use by all LSOM students.
- Discover Ireland Tours donated 6 full size cellos

Partnership Programmes
